U.S-India bilateral trade is projected to grow to \$238 billion by 2025

The US-India Strategic Partnership Forum (USISPF) estimates that U.S.-India bilateral trade is likely to grow from \$143 billion to \$238 billion by 2025. This growth will occur if trade grows by 7.5% each year, this has been the trend for the last 7 years. The estimate also projects that by 2025, bilateral trade could range between \$283 billion to \$327 billion, at an annual average growth rate of 10%-12.5%.

India Investment Seminar on "Indian Budget and Its Implications"

investors, academicians, think-tankers and informed them that the recent budget has attempted to give more space for the private sector. General David H Petraeus, former Director of CIA, during the conversation with Vikram J Singh of USISPF, brought clarity on the construct of Indo-Pacific. He explained what Indo-Pacific means to the partners and said that the United States recently renamed the Pacific Command as Indo-Pacific



Command underlining the growing importance of Indian subcontinent. Recent trade and security issues between significant trading countries have highlighted the importance of free trade and rules-based international order. The conversation was followed by a Q&A where General Petraeus answered questions relating to US-Pakistan relations, the investment environment in growing markets, struggle against extremism, and the Iranian economy and sanctions.
